PENNSYLVANIA AGGREGATES AND CONCRETE ASSOCIATION COMMENDS IRRC ON WATER QUALITY STANDARD FOR MANGANESE AND IMPLEMENTATION RULING

"With the ruling now behind us, PACA would welcome the opportunity to work with DEP on proposed regulations that comply with the intent of Act 40."
