















U.S. % Share 2019-2022





Index, 2000=100





Permit Activity 2016-2028






Total Permits by County

The top 10 counties account for 2/3s of PA permits.










PA Home Sales Inventory





Months of Supply – All Home Types



Index, 2000=100




Home Affordability by County






PA Lodging Market Share



Millennial Home Ownership




 Over the past five years, the millennial homeownership rate has increased faster than that of other generations






Non-Residential Cement Consumption Share PA







US Manufacturing Employment (000s)





General Activity – Current vs. Previous Month (% SA)



Net Farm Income – Gross Receipts








PA Population Picture





Net Migration




5 Year Average Net Migration % of Population






Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act by County

Implied Total by County (Ths. \$)











State Gas Tax Increased or Reforms




Apparent Use of Highway Cement (4 Yr. Average)





Index, 2000=100


