- All golfers must abide by course rules/instructions. Rules related to tournament play will be announced prior to the start of the tournament.
- The format for this tournament is a four-person SCRAMBLE format.
- Fee includes greens fee, cart, range balls and three (3) drink tickets.
- Drink tickets may be used for water, soft drinks, Gatorade and beer - no liquor, tobacco or food. And, no outside food or beverages are permitted on the course. Carry-on coolers are prohibited.
- No metal spikes permitted. Soft spikes are mandatory.
- Proper dress required - no jeans/denim, tank tops or t-shirts. Knee-length shorts or long pants are required.
- Collared shirts required. Ladies shirts must have a collar or sleeves but may not lack both.
- Foursomes are subject to change at the discretion of the Golf Pro without notice if necessity warrants and PACA WILL NOT make changes to foursomes based on requests. All foursomes are final.
- Winners will be announced and prizes will be awarded immediately following tournament during the closing reception. Prizes will be awarded to the first and second place teams and three (3) skill prize winners.
- Rental clubs are available, but requests must be made in advance of arrival at Skytop Lodge for Summer Summit
