We are looking forward to building on previous year's



HANK BAUER AWARD

Presented to the industry professional who has made an exceptional effort in promoting the concrete industry

- Brief essay supporting the nomination minimum of 200 words
- List of accomplishments
- Photographs should be color prints of good quality for use in a PowerPoint presentation should the nominee be selected. Electronic photographs must be a minimum of at least three megapixels.

Nominee may come from any member category - Producer or Associate

PROJECT OF THE YEAR

Any ready mixed project in the state of Pennsylvania may be submitted for judging. Entries will be evaluated on the submittal package. Submittals should be professional in appearance and highlight the merits of the project.

The wining project will recognize, at a minimum, the ready mixed concrete producer and the concrete contractor. Architects and engineers may also be included as the nature of the project dictates.

Categories

- Commercial Includes the construction of office buildings, hotels, shopping centers, hospitals, warehouses, etc. May include streets, bridges, parking areas, walkways, courtyards, etc.
- Residential Includes single family homes, townhouses, condominiums, etc. May include driveways, walkways, courtyards, etc.
- Decorative Includes any pavement/surface incorporating colored, stamped, stained, etched, etc. concrete.
 May be either a commercial or residential project.
- Projects must have been completed between September 30, 2024 and September 20, 2025.
- Projects must have been supplied by a PACA ready mixed concrete producer member
- The size of the project or volume of concrete WILL NOT be a factor in the judging
- At least three 8"x10" color photos of good quality MUST be included in the submittal package. Digital photos may be submitted on a CD or thumb drive and MUST be at least three megapixels.
- Package must include a 200-word minimum description of the project that emphasizes those areas that make the
 project noteworthy or exceptional. These may include workmanship, problems encountered and solved during
 construction, etc.
