GOLF TOURNAMENT INFØ

- All golfers must abide by course rules/instructions. Rules related to tournament play will be announced prior to the start of the tournament.
- The format for this tournament is a four-person SCRAMBLE format.
- Fee includes greens fee, cart, range balls and three (3) drink tickets.
- Drink tickets may be used for water, soft drinks, Gatorade and beer no liquor, tobacco or food. And, no outside food or beverages are permitted on the course. Carry-on coolers are prohibited.
- No metal spikes permitted. Soft spikes are mandatory.
- Proper dress required no jeans/denim, tank tops or t-shirts. Knee-length shorts or long pants are required.
- Collared shirts required. Ladies shirts must have a collar or sleeves but may not

FLY FISHING EXCURSION INFO

- Cost includes fly rods, 4 flies & instruction on casting.
- Skytop is strictly catch and release.
- Prior to arrival, all attendees going fishing will need to purchase a PA fishing permit (PA resident 1 Day \$14.47 or PA resident Annual \$27.97) and trout stamp (\$14.97).
- The excursion will begin at 1:00 pm for a 3-hour experience. 2 hours will be instruction and the last 1 hour will be at the stream fishing.
- Excursion is limited to the first 25 people to register and pay.

NEW FORMAT FOR 2025!

- The wobble trap presents the bird differently each time it is shot, both vertically and horizontally.
- The organizer may opt to throw a second bird immediately after the first shot without the shooter calling pull.
- The Lodge's elevated five stand has two ground platforms, two mid-level platforms (about 7 steps up), and one top-level platform (about 7 steps up from mid-level).
- Groups will be teams of 6.
- Using the Lodge's elevated five stand, each team would be on a different platform, three of the platforms would shoot off one of the wobble traps, while the other two platforms would shoot off the other wobble trap, allowing for faster shooting. The assumption is that everyone is a competent shooter and can load their own firearms.
- Once the teams have shot the designated amount of ammo for that platform, they will rotate to the next platform to shoot the next designated amount of ammo. This process will continue until they have shot all the ammo.
- This tournament will use 100 rounds. Gun rental is available please indicate if you need a rental gun when you register to participate.

 Or, you may bring your own gun. Bringing your own ammo is prohibited. Ammo will be provided by the Lodge.
